 - Provide relevant and updated information that relates field knowledge to Home Stretch curriculum
- Abide by all confidentiality policies and procedures
- Update contact information with HUD Housing Counselor
- Provide knowledge of significant developments and trends in the industry

Who should apply? This role is suited for someone with strong communication and presentation skills who enjoys connecting with people from diverse backgrounds. Applicants should have a connection to Hennepin County and work in a field related to homeownership.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Some evening and weekend availability
- Strong communication skills
- Fluent in English
- Able to follow instructions clearly and efficiently
- Proficient with Zoom and working with computers, and ability to coach clients through using Zoom
- Able to establish and maintain a strong internet connection
- Organized and able to manage their time effectively
- Applicants with previous presentation and volunteer experience are preferred
- Bi-lingual applicants are also encouraged to apply.
